## Background

A former English teacher who served as deputy attorney general in the California state attorney general's office; following an unsuccessful bid in California's 2021 gubernatorial special election, the former state assemblyman ran for Congress in California's 3rd District

Earned a BA at Harvard University, a JD at Yale University Law School, and a MA in secondary education at Loyola Marymount University

Prior to law school, he taught 10th grade English at an "inner city public high school" in Southern Los Angeles

After a stint practicing private law, Kiley served as deputy attorney general in the Appeals, Writs, and Trials Division of the California attorney general's office, where he worked cases involving convicted felons

Elected to California state assembly to represent the sixth district in 2016 and has subsequently been twice reelected

Serves as vice-chair on the Assembly Privacy and Consumer Protection and Education committees also sits on the Assembly Higher Education, Housing and Community Development, Judiciary, and Budget committees, as well as the Joint Legislative Audit and Legislative Budget committees
